**TRR club category definitions:** we have had some questions in the recent past and wanted to 'get down to brass tacks' on what they mean:

**Renegade:** this shooter can pick a different category at any and all stages. One stage they can shoot gunfighter, the next duelist, another C-D and so on. Only requirement is they follow the guidelines for the category picked during that stage, no combining of various categories components; **Violet** calls this the 'Sampler Plate' of categories.

**BAM (Bolt Action Military):** this is an extension of Wild Bunch (WB) and we're glad to welcome any of these shooters to TRR. (See following article for details.) And being a cutting-edge club we have two (2) options for this:

**BAM-CD**: this is the current C-D category with the BAM rifle used in place of the lever action. Single action revolvers and choice of shotgun are up to the shooter.

**BAM-WB:** this is the current WB category with the BAM rifle used in place of the lever action. Again, the shooter will engage the C-D targets.

**The BAM Category in detail**: This category will be available to shooters at any TRR monthly match.

The rules for this category are as follows:

- 1. Bolt Action Military (BAM) category shooters will be integrated into a regular posse similar to Cody-Dixon shooters during a Cowboy Action Shooting match.
- 2. Shooters should wear period-correct (1890-1946) and preferably military style clothing, boots, and a hat.
- 3. BAM shooters will engage the Cody-Dixon targets in the sequence described in the scenario. Rifle target distance will be from 50 to 150 yards. Targets may be of varying sizes, with smaller targets being used for the closer ranges.

- 4. Rifle must be an original caliber bolt action rifle issued by any country to its Military Forces through the end of WWII.
- a. Rifle must be "as issued" with original iron battle sights and no external modifications.
- b. Internal modifications and faithful reproductions are allowed.
- c. Shooter starts with no more than 5 rounds in the magazine, chamber empty and the bolt open. If the rifle will not hold five rounds in the magazine, any over-capacity rounds may be staged, or loaded from the body, while on the clock.
- d. Shooter **must use solid lead bullets only** but gas checks are allowed.
- e. All rifle shots must be fired "off-hand." No leaning, supporting, or resting is allowed.

BAM-CD: BAM rifle takes place of lever action rifle; all other guns follow SASS cowboy rules

**BAM-WB**: Normal WB pistol and Model 97 shotgun are to be used. Shotgun may be any Model 97 or Model 12 shotgun meeting SASS Wild Bunch criteria and will be fired in the same sequence and order as in the Wild Bunch categories.
