**RO** Training: as you can see we had great success with our RO Classes. Nineteen separate cowfolk took the classes with 11 attending both of them. Each class was over 4 hours long with tests at the end. Of special note is the RO II test which is closed-book and passing requires missing no more than 3 questions out of 30 = 90% required to pass.

**Club Election is** \( \textstyle{\textstyle{1}}\) **a-comin' down the tracks\( \textstyle{1}\):** getting closer to our election which is held at the first match in March, Mar 7. Way the by-laws read: Those who have been nominated can, but do not have to, make a speech at the first match in February, Feb 1. Just so you know.

**RO rule changes:** The one major change to our rules is that now, if a rifle is to brought cocked or half-cocked to the line from the loading table, the shooter is required to come to full cock, if needed, aim at the berm and pull the trigger. If the rifle fires the shooter gets a Stage DQ and is sent to the unloading table. If nothing happens it is a no-call and the shooter proceeds with the stage.

Before 2020 the cocked hammer situation would result in an automatic Stage DQ.

Thanks to all the cowboys on the SASS Wire who stepped forward and shared the repair method with us.


