Got my paper targets set up and time to start shooting and adjusting, etc. After 20 or so rounds I was in the center and happy as a cat in a canary cage. To be sure I shot off-hand to be certain the bullets would still go when I wanted them to and they did.

What I didn't realize till this experience was the accuracy you can get using shooting sticks. If you adjust the sticks so you can put a sand bag under the rear of the stock you end up with a rock-solid configuration from which to blast away. No more breathing or weakening shoulder muscles to throw your aim off. You can really get you sights on the target.

Now I'm not ready to join the Long Range group but I can see why this type of shooting can be so much fun.
