A Look Back at Our Current Range: We are starting our 8<sup>th</sup> year at our present location. Many of us remember loading up the stage buildings at Ricky's first location, driving down FM 1488 and 1774, crossing the low water crossing with the



buildings on our trailers and staging them on the South 40 parking area.

Then came a good 6 months of waiting for the field, for it was just a bare spot in the woods, to dry out and start moving, repairing and improving everything you presently see above the ground plus wires and piles below.

Cost estimates for having all of this done professionally range somewhere between \$1-2 million . . . and all this was donated by our members!

We shot our first couple of matches off hay bales and a few loading/unloading tables and we loved it! It was cowboy shooting in its most basic form and we were as happy as ducks in a swarm of June bugs.

And we didn't stop, haven't stopped since then. With each passing season we have continued to improve as needed. We see this is a continual work in progress.



# What does the High Cost of Primers mean for a Us at a Match?

As we all know, primer prices have tripled or quadrupled in the last few years. Where we once could find them for \$40, presently it takes \$100 to \$125 for the same amount.



Now we have people like **Tell Sackett** who has taken it upon himself to search out and buy <u>out of his own pocket</u> both SP and LP primers so our members can continue to shoot—he sells them at his cost, too. The prices are in line with current market costs but at least they are available.

But what does this mean for "Cowboy Joe" as he reloads for a match? We are going to look at our current 5 stage matches for this; it keeps the math simple:

- A 5-stage match requires 100 metallic cartridges
- Back in the day, when primers were 3-4¢ each that comes out to \$3-4
  dollar for primers for a match
- o Now the primers are 10-12¢ = \$10-12 for the same 100 cartridges
- Simply put it is now costing Cowboy Joe an additional \$7-8 more to shoot, everything else, bullets, powder, being the same.

I know everyone's situation is different and each person has to decide if this additional cost is *the straw that breaks the camel's back* as far as shooting goes.

Couple of other thoughts:

You can shoot just once a month vs. twice

You can shoot in the .22 category and save a bit of cash doing this.
